Cerebral Palsy Sports Federation of India (CPSFI) is a recognised National Sports Federation (NSF), an apex body in India, developing and promoting sports for persons with Cerebral Palsy and related neurological conditions, providing them a platform and opportunities to showcase their sporting capabilities (www.cpsfi.org).

The Department of Sports, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports (MYAS), Government of India, has recognised CPSFI as a National Sports Federation (NSF) in the 'Priority' category. CPSFI has been mandated to promote and develop sports for persons with cerebral palsy in India.

CPSFI is the only national member of CPISRA & IFCPF.

CPISRA is the leading international sports organisation governing and promoting sport and recreation for Cerebral Palsy (CP) and related neurological conditions. CPISRA is a founding organisation of the Paralympics and one of only four IOSD recognised by the IPC to represent impairment groups.

IFCPF, International Federation of CP Football, is the international governing body for the sport of CP Football and are the 'Recognised International Sport Federation' of IPC.

Vision

Creating Opportunities. Changing lives.

"To create a platform for people with cerebral palsy and related neurological conditions to participate in adaptive sports which help improve their physical, psychological & social well being".

Mission

To pioneer a cerebral palsy sports movement in India.

- By building awareness, nurturing talent, training athletes and creating opportunities for competitions leading to Paralympics.
- Facilitate a cerebral palsy sports experience centre which offers state-of-the-art sports facilities, equipments, technical & classification expertise & sports science support.
- Ensure availability & affordability of sports equipments like frame runner & boccia balls/slides.



CPSFI has set a goal of 25 medals in the category for cerebral palsy in the Paralympics. "Lakshya Paralympics" is an initiative to high performance train athletes who are promising and probables for Paralympics. The National Athletics Championship 2022 was one such platform where athletes are being identified for induction into the "Lakshya Paralympics" program.





Executive Board

The Executive Board of CPSFI comprises of people from all walks of life, young and experienced and from different parts of the country.

CPSFI is led by Rajesh Tomar, graduate from St Stephen's College, Delhi University. He has contributed to the field of sports and para sports extensively. Having been a national athlete himself, he understands the need for sports and opportunities for an athlete. He switched to contributing for para sports in the last decade.

Mr Tomar has completed a term as vice-president Asian Paralympic Committee (APC). He was the president, Paralympic Committee of India (PCI) and also in the leadership team of various sports organisations and committees.



CPSFI's 4-stage Process

CPSFI has a four stage process to achieve our objectives & goals. Starting from building awareness around the need of sports, the adaptive cp sports that we promote, idetifying the right sport for a child, different levels / kinds of training to competitions at different level.



Sangiti, Awareness Program (31 so far)

Our awareness program on cp sports wherein we meet organisations who have been working for the cause of Cerebral Palsy and introduce cp sports to different stakeholders like the staff, physiotherapists, individual with cerebral palsy and their parents.



Pratibha Yogyata, Talent hunt Program (2 so far)

Our talent hunt program as a followup of Sangiti is to identify children who are interested in sports and guide them with appropriate sport/s involving medical experts to ensure the sport chosen does not aggravate the disability or cause injury, thereby is the right one.



Prashikshan, Training Program (6 so far)

Our training camps for children in the sport they have chosen. We also conduct training programs to train the trainers, to capacitate them to handle cp children and also be updated of the technicalities of the sport. Programs to understand classification and train classifiers.



Pratiyogita, Competitions (2 Pratiyogita so far)

We encourage distric level & state level competitive sporting events. We also conduct national level meets for various cp sports we promote.



NCPFC2022 - Report

CPSFI conducted its Inaugural National CP Football Championship 2022 from 25-28 August 2022 at the Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium, New Delhi. Over 120 participants were at the event, 10 teams (8 boys & 2 girls) from member States/UTs participated at the Nationals after qualifying at their zonal level competitions. There has been 100% participation of our affiliated units in the entire process of National CP Football Championship 2022. There was no entry fee charged.

Teams were accommodated at the SAI hostel, JLN Stadium. Food, prescribed by the SAI hostel nutritionist was provided at the hostel premises. Medanta, our medical partner provided us with doctor consultation, a physiotherapist, nurses (male and female), first aid kits & emergency medicine & an ambulance, during the entire event, round the clock.

Ms Sujata Chaturvedi, Secretary Sports, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and her team of officials from the Ministry were a part of our opening ceremony. She inaugurated the Championship and declared it open. Her presence and encouraging words were inspiring to all officials and players.

A IFCPF 3-member delegation of Sam Turner, Secretary General & CEO, IFCPF along with Matías Henríquez, IFCPF classification manager and Charlotte Messiaen, IFCPF classification education coordinator, was invited to support us in the classification of players and technical conduct of the matches. CP Football Classification Certificate Workshop was conducted for our coaches/trainers and team managers on 26th August 2022.

Football Delhi, an affiliated member of All India Football Federation (AIFF) partnered with CPSFI for the technical support. Their scouts team helped us identify top players who will comprise the India CP Football Men's team and also ensured all the matches were conducted professionally.

Teams

The 8 men's teams that made it to the Nationals after their zonal level competitions were grouped into 2. Team A and Team B. Group A comprised of teams from Rajasthan, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar and Kerala. Group B had Punjab, Jharkhand, Tamil Nadu and Haryana. Girls teams played each other. A total of 19 matches were played. Matches were scheduled in 2 sessions, early morning 7-11 am. and evening 4-10 pm keeping in mind the heat during the day. Floodlights were used for the evening sessions.

Classification

CP Football team composition is based on the class of players. Therefore classification of players is a critical and essential part of the whole process. This is the first time classification of cp football players was conducted in India and the process was done on the 25th & 26th Aug 2022 by the IFCPF team. Physical assessment, technical assessment and observation assessment are done before allocation of the sports class. A total of 74 boys and girls were classified, of which 6 were declared NE (Not Eligible) and 1 CNC (classification not completed).

The coaches/trainers/team managers accompanying the players were exposed to the classification process.



CP Football Classification Certificate Workshop, 26th August 2022

The IFCPF team conducted a CP Football Classification Certificate Workshop on the 26th August, morning session. The workshop included theory session and on-field learning as well. 18 officials from our member States/UTs attended the same and on successful completion awarded a participation certificate by IFCPF & CPSFI.

26th, 27th & 28th August

Matches were played 26th afternoon onwards. 4 matches every session made sure all teams played a match. Football Delhi's referees, scout team and the support staff were present right through all the matches ensuring smooth and professional conduct of the matches. Medanta's medical team was present on the field for the medical support.

Dr Anjuman Bains, psychologist conducted 2 sessions on importance of mental health for sports persons. Her half hour session was attended by the players, coaches and team managers. Dr Bains helped the participants understand how the mind can be crucial in deciding one's response to a situation and how one can keep it calm.

Mr Kapil Dev, the legend, the idol for many dropped by and kickstarted a match. He met the playing teams and interacted with the other players too. Mr Dev was gracious to visit the CPSFI office where Dr Anjuman Bains was conducting the 2nd session. He had an interactive session with the players spending quality time with them. Mr Dev was gifted with the championship t-shirt and a memento.

28th August saw the clash of Haryana and Kerala in the first semi final and Tamil Nadu and Bihar in the second. Kerala and Tamil Nadu reached the finals with their teams outdoing the other teams.

The finals was a nail biting match and as exciting as a final could get. At full time both teams were tied at 2 goals each. The extra time saw Kerala team score and finish with 5-2 emerging the Champions. Tamil Nadu team were the runners-up of the inaugural National CP Football Championship 2022.

The scouts team identified 25 players who could possibly comprise of the India CP Football team.

Closing Ceremony

All teams consisting of players, officials, team managers alongwith CPSFI volunteers, officials walked together to some music which brought out a lot of emotions in the participants. The award ceremony was filled with a lot of joy. The Punjab girls emerged winners in the women category. The best goalkeeper, men was given to Tejinder Singh (Jharkhand), the best defender was Abdul Muneer (Kerala), best mid-fielder was Rahul (Tamil Nadu) and best forward was Naveen (Haryana), the best player of the tournament was Sijo George (captain, Kerala). The runners-up trophy and silver medals were given to every member of the Tamil Nadu team. The winners trophy and the gold medals were given away to all the members of the Kerala team. All the winners celebrated their achievement.


