INTRODUCTION

CPSFI, Cerebral Palsy Sports Federation of India is an apex body promoting Cerebral Palsy Sports, providing the athletes with a platform and opportunities to showcase their sporting capabilities.

CPSFI is the only national member of CPISRA & IFCPF.

CPISRA is the leading international sports organisation governing and promoting sport and recreation for Cerebral Palsy (CP) and related neurological conditions. CPISRA is a founding organisation of the Paralympics and one of only four International Organisations of Sport for the Disabled (IOSD) recognised by the International Paralympic Committee (IPC) to represent impairment groups.

IFCPF, International Federation of CP Football, is the international governing body for the sport of CP Football and are the ‘Recognised International Sport Federation’ of International Paralympic Committee.

CPSFI is conducting the inaugural “National CP Football Championship 2020” (for boys & men) from 21-24 March 2020 at the Colourfield arena (astro turf) of the prestigious Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium, New Delhi.

CPSFI has partnered with All India Football Federation (AIFF) for technical conduct of the event and selection of the “National CP Football Team”

- No escorts permitted
- **FREE local transportation**/bus to & fro Jawaharlal Nehru Stadium-Vishwa Yuvak Kendra
- **FREE playing kits** (jersey, shorts, stockings & shin guards) would be provided to participating teams
- Winner and runner-up would be presented with medals and certificates
- The winning team would be presented with a trophy
- Participation certificates would be given to all participants
- Award for the **‘Best Player’** & **‘Promising Player’**
- **AIFF technical officials would select potential players during the Championship to form the National team which would represent India at International events/-tournaments**
- **Participation certificates of CPISRA World CP Games 2018 would be handed over to the athletes who participated in the Games**
